THE MDIS EXPERIENCE

MDIS began the year with a great deal to celebrate. The inaugural MDIS-Leeds Beckett University Graduation Ceremony held in January, marked our very first graduation for year 2018. Of the 98 graduates, a remarkable 47 attained 1st Class Honours. We wish them every success in their future endeavours and a warm welcome to the MDIS Alumni Network.

In April, one of our leaders, Dr R Theyvendran, MDIS Secretary-General and past Chairman of Singapore Indian Chamber of Commerce & Industry, was conferred a 'Lifetime Business Achievement Award' at the Singapore Indian Entrepreneur Awards 2018, in recognition of his outstanding contributions to business.

In May, MDIS proudly launched the private education sector's first dedicated School of Nursing. Graced by Guest-of-Honour, Dr Chia Shi-Lu, Member of Parliament for Tanjong Pagar GRC, the launch also marked the official opening of the MDIS Nursing Practicum Lab, a well-equipped facility for post-registered nurses to enhance their practical skills. The school aims to recruit 2,000 students by 2025 to meet Singapore's increasing need for personnel in the public healthcare sector.

Another highlight in May was Kolej MDIS Malaysia's first convocation ceremony. A total of 164 diploma students received their qualifications on 5 May. It gives me great pleasure to welcome them to the MDIS Alumni network.

I am also proud to introduce a refreshed look for the Bond Magazine, that is visually captivating with a touch of fun and youthfulness. It would be great to receive your feedback, so do get in touch with us.

WHY DID YOU CHOOSE TO STUDY IN MDIS?

I was really drawn to the well-equipped hospitality training centre at MDIS School of Tourism and Hospitality. Furthermore, the school offered internship opportunities and also industry visits. Such experiences were important to me as I wanted to gain real-world experiences that in my opinion, are key to enhancing my employability upon graduation.

WHAT IS THE HARDEST PART OF YOUR JOB?

Chingay is a massive project and one of national importance. During the set-up, challenges arose from having to manage a lot of different stakeholders ranging from vendors, volunteers, performers, to contractors, and more. WHAT DO YOU LIKE THE MOST ABOUT YOUR JOB?

As mentioned, I have to liaise and manage a variety of stakeholders. With time, rapport is built and slowly, everyone gels together as one Chingay family. Working together for a common goal, the bond we build is something I really cherish.

And of course, when we successfully completed the Chingay Parade, the satisfaction derived is euphoric. Seeing a successful parade and hearing compliments about how the parade was done well really made all the hard work and late nights worth it. Eventhough I have been doing this for four years now, the feeling never gets old.

WHAT IS SUCCESS TO YOU?

To me, success is not about being rich or reputable. It is being able to do what you like and getting a sense of achievement after every victory.

WE UNDERSTAND THAT IT WAS YOUR FIRST TIME PARTICIPATING IN CHINGAY. WHAT DO YOU LIKE MOST ABOUT IT?

I never expected that I would enjoy performing in the Chingay Parade to this extent. It had definitely been a fun-filled journey, but what was especially amazing was the forging of new bonds and celebrating new friendships with the diverse MDIS performers from many different backgrounds and cultures.

TELL US ABOUT YOUR JOURNEY IN MDIS.

After I finished high school in China, I enrolled in a Bachelor of Science (Hons) in Business & Management Studies, awarded by the University of Bradford, UK. Subsequently, I furthered my studies and graduated with an MBA, awarded by the University of Sunderland, UK. During my time in MDIS, I was the Dance Club president and the event secretary for the Student Council. Currently, I am working in the MDIS Membership Department, where I help plan and organise activities for our MDIS members.

WE UNDERSTAND THAT YOU HAVE BEEN THE CHOREOGRAPHER FOR MDIS CHINGAY CONTINGENT OVER THE PAST FOUR YEARS. WHAT WAS ONE OF THE BIGGEST CHALLENGES IN DOING THIS?

To me, developing the choreography is not difficult. The biggest challenge comes from teaching the choreography to the whole MDIS contingent made up of over 60 students. Usually, the majority of performers would have no prior experience in dancing and would thus require a lot of training to get the moves right. At the start, most of them are fearful of performing. Slowly but surely, they start to get better not only in their dance but also in gaining more personal confidence. This is why I have been doing this year after year. Seeing their progress and them eventually enjoying the performance truly warms my heart. I derive a lot of satisfaction from that.

WHAT IS YOUR BIGGEST TAKEAWAY IN MDIS?

My time in MDIS is really made up of several defining chapters of my life. As a student, MDIS had equipped me with relevant knowledge and skills to prepare me for the workplace. MDIS had also allowed me to develop my interest and pursue my passions through various student interest groups. Now, I am also building my career and achieving my work aspirations in MDIS. Most importantly, I met my Mr. Right in MDIS as well! We got married last year in 2017. Fun Fact: 2017's Chingay Parade was just two days before our wedding ceremony, which we still went ahead and participated in together!
