COURSE SYNOPSIS

This course covers the methodology and techniques necessary for developing effective online training solutions. It takes a systematic approach to equip learners with the right strategy to develop powerful and engaging training instructions. The format of training covered include webinar, virtual instructor-led training (VILT), blended learning or asynchronous e-learning.

Participants will gain a good appreciation of how people learn in a virtual platform. They will develop solutions that engage learners cognitively and emotionally.

Participants will be introduced to:

- Instructional design models and adult learning theory
- Designing and developing training plans and activities
- Engaging learners using learning technologies and virtual tools

OUTCOMES

At the end of the course, participants will be able to scope an online training project, map strategy for virtual delivery, design lesson plan and activities. They will be able to build professional and powerful e-learning courses that meet the organisation's learning objectives and aligned with industry practices. This course includes an optional one-to-one e-learning project consultation.

COURSE SYNOPSIS

This is a hands-on workshop that covers the necessary software to get started with online course development. Participants will be introduced to the essential features of popular Learning Management Systems (LMS) and authoring tools. They will learn the strategies and methods to transform eLearning into engaging learning resources by integrating voice-over, videos, animations, visuals, online quizzes and surveys, just to name a few.

Participants will be introduced to:

- Learning Management System (LMS) and authoring tools such as Blackboard, Moodle, Articulate, Adobe Captivate, Camtasia, Canva, etc
- Creating course storyboards and prototypes
- Adding interactive online activities such as polls, quizzes, drag and drops or case scenarios
- Integrating multimedia assets such as voice-over, graphics, video and audio
- Managing an e-Learning project in accordance to project scope and learning objectives
- Delivering a e-learning project

OUTCOMES

By the end of this course, participants will be able to choose appropriate editing and authoring tools to develop effective and engaging e-learning materials. They will build effective learning solutions for the new generation of learners accessing from anywhere and anytime. Before completion, participants will be required to build a 30-minutes online course.
